This educational institution has been started by Chinmaya Mission members with much efforts and support of well-wishers and generous public in the Panchayath , with the intention of imparting quality education. Timely help of Federal Bank led by offering loans for construction of buildings and infrastructure development. Fees collection is the only income of the school and fee payment is often not received on time. For the Academic Year 2019-20 more than 2.5 lakhs and in 20-21, more than 10 lakhs is pending. Fee structure was revised during the Academic Year 2017-18. In 2020, we proposed 10% increase in fees, but due to covid-19 pandemic, it was not implemented. At the time of covid ,we had provided financial assistance to all the parents by providing 5% discount. In addition to this, we have given financial support to more than 117 students which impacted to 37 lakhs.

We have not taken any new recruitment for the past two years and staff increment/DA not provided since 2019. You can realise the difficulties faced by the management as stated above.

Once again, CVK applauds the contribution of each one of you to ensure the success of our students. Let us commit ourselves to offer holistic education, spread the culture of creativity and innovation and create outstanding personalities.

2. FEES REMITTANCE (Between 9:30am and 2:00pm)

First instalment fee remittance schedule is as follows – 5th May, 2022 – 15th May,2022.

5. WE CAN WE MUST

- Attendance is mandatory on the reopening day.
- Students must attend classes from the 1st day of the new session regularly and in a punctual way.
- In case of taking leave prior information to be given to the respective class teacher by the parent.
- Students should come in neatly ironed, full uniform with ID cards, polished shoes on all working days, open houses and other school functions.
ANKLE SOCKS, OTHER STYLE OF SHOES, TORN SHOES OR SOCKS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
- School timing must be strictly adhered to. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against late comers.
- The black track suit and T-shirt should be of proper length.
- Boys should maintain normal, short haircut throughout the year. (Navy cut and fancy hair cuts are not allowed)
- Boys of higher classes should come with proper shaved faces.
- Girls with long hair should plait their hair with white bands with maximum two black slides. Girls with short hair have to wear white hair band. Coloring of hair is not permitted.
- Nails are to be trimmed regularly. Use of nail polish is to be avoided.
- Wearing ear drops and second studs, and other gold ornaments are strictly prohibited.
- Only vegetarian food must be brought to school.
- Kindly avoid plastic tiffin boxes and water bottles.

- Kindly refrain from using poly-bags or plastic bags as far as possible.
- Mobile phones are not permitted in the school campus
- Birthdays – PREKG to class V children can wear colour dress on Birthdays. As our school facilitates an eco friendly environment, all students are refrained from bringing sweets to school on birthday. Instead, donating a book to school library will be much appreciated. Bringing cakes and exchange of gifts among students /staff members on any occasion are strictly prohibited. Class VI upwards should wear school uniform on all occasions including birthdays.
- If any defaulters, parents will be informed to take them home and to bring back to school after rectifying the fault.

Behavioral and financial discipline inculcated in childhood takes the child a long way in his life. Instructions on uniforms and other matters are intended for the well being of students.
